2. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average (high school or college) of a minimum of 2.0.
3. Official transcript documenting cumulative grade point average shall be attached to application.
4. Preference will be given to applicants who have been active in a Hernando County 4-H, FFA, or Junior Cattlemen group and/or whose parents are Hernando County Cattlemen members.
5. Please attach a 500 – 800 word essay on your accomplishments and your goals associated with Agriculture, and why Agriculture is important in your life.
6. Included in the essay shall be a summarization of your 4-H and/or FFA experience(s).
